

**PART 2: *BY-LAWS of the***  
***ALLEN COUNTY ATHLETIC CONFERENCE***  
***HIGH SCHOOL DIVISION***

**I. *GENERAL***

- A. By-law changes shall be added to or taken from this section by enactment through a vote of five (5) of the seven (7) membership.
- B. To qualify as members, Conference schools must field teams in basketball and football. Schools failing to field teams in basketball and football will be placed on probationary status and be required to field teams in these sports within a two (2) year period. At the end of this probationary period a vote will be taken by the membership to either continue the school's probationary status or drop the school from the Conference.
- C. Unless otherwise stated and determined, the rules of the National Federation of State High School Athletic Associations and the IHSAA will be followed.
- D. In all Conference tournaments, if there is a deficit it will be covered by the Conference treasury. And if there is a profit it will be turned into the Conference treasury, except for the basketball tourney in which all schools will share equally in the profit.
- E. To be considered a Conference sport, one-half of the member schools (four schools) must participate in the sport.
- F. In case of any ties resulting in any of the Conference Sports, the conference tie-breaking procedure will be enacted.
- G. The Team Champion in each sport will receive a trophy.
- H. Protests or any other disputes between member schools shall be referred to the Executive Committee for action.
- I. All awards received by All-Conference Athletes will be uniform. They will be presented at the close of each sport.
- J. Admission price for Varsity, Junior Varsity and Freshman contests will be determined in the spring meeting each year for the next upcoming year. Admission for all Varsity contests will be \$7.00. All other lower level (JV and Freshman) contests held in a separate session from the Varsity level will be \$6.00.
- K. Admission prices for all Varsity Tournaments will be \$7.00 per session or \$15.00 season tickets.
- L. In all sports where Conference Championships (regular season or tournament) are to be determined, official IHSAA rules will be used to break any ties in the games that may occur. Official IHSAA guidelines would also be used for any suspended games due to weather or other circumstances.

**II. *CONTEST RULES AND COMPLETION***

- A. All ACAC contests will be governed by NFHS/IHSAA, USGA/IHSAA, or USTA/IHSAA rules.
- B. Completion of all ACAC contests will follow the standards established in IHSAA State Tournament Series for each respective sport.
- C. Suspended contests may be conceded by the coach or athletic director of the team trailing in the score at the time of the suspension of play.

**III. *TIE-BREAKING PROCEDURE***

- A. Ties will be broken by based on the result of the head-to-head matchup.
- B. In the case of three or more teams being tied the following method will be used –

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1. The results of the teams who are tied for a particular spot will be compared to their result against the last place team. Any team losing to the last place team will be eliminated from the tie.
2. If more than two teams involved in the tie defeated the last place team, the process will move to comparing results against the next lowest finishing team.
3. Once a head-to-head matchup is established through the elimination process, the head-to-head winner will be declared as the champion.

### ***IV. ALL CONFERENCE SELECTION PROCEDURE***

#### **A. ACAC SELECTION MEETING GUIDELINES**

- a. This information should be read aloud by the presider at the beginning of each Allen County Athletic Conference Selection meeting.
- b. A player, who is nominated and selected here today to represent the ACAC, should:
  - i. Exhibit outstanding skill in this sport.
  - ii. Provide positive leadership for your team.
  - iii. Have the kind of character and exhibit the kind of moral and ethical behavior to be a positive representative of your school and the ACAC.
- c. At this meeting, coaches are reminded that:
  - i. The purpose of an all-conference meeting is to select the best representatives of the ACAC.
  - ii. You have a responsibility to vote for the best players regardless of your desire to have one of your own players make this team.
  - iii. You are asked to keep coach's personalities, personal likes and dislikes, and past grudges from affecting your votes in this process.
  - iv. If you have a question about a player's statistics, character, or position, you should feel free to ask that player's coach prior to any votes being cast.
- d. After this meeting, coaches are reminded that:
  - i. The process is not perfect and there will always be differences of opinions with regards to identifying the best players and the most worthy players for all-conference honors.
  - ii. This is a secret ballot and the results of those ballots are not open to interpretation or discussion outside the meeting.
  - iii. You have an obligation to support the Allen County Athletic Conference and this process of selecting all conference teams.
  - iv. You are not expected to publicly air your negative thoughts or concerns about another coach, another school, another player, the selection process, or the Allen County Athletic Conference.

#### **B. INDIVIDUAL SPORTS (Cross Country, Golf, Swimming, Wrestling, Track and Field)**

- a. All Conference members will be determined based upon athletes finish in the Conference Tournament as outlined in each specific sport.
- b. Every attempt will be made to complete conference tournaments. Cancellations and Postponements may cause the need to make modifications to the tournament format.
- c. If Conference Tournament is not held, then there will be no All-Conference selections for that sport that year.

#### **C. TEAM SPORTS (Football, Soccer, Volleyball, Basketball, Baseball, Softball, Tennis)**

- a. Players nominated by their Coach by Position: outlined in each sport below
  - i. Must have played 50% of the season at the position being nominated for

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- ii. Pitches in baseball and softball are excluded from this
- b. Coaches cannot vote for his or her athlete
- c. Voting will take place by Secret Ballot
- d. Nominations are to be kept by the host Athletic Director
- e. Athletic Director responsible for that team sport will host the All-Conference Selection Meeting and will set the date, time, and location of the meeting.
- f. Presiding Athletic Director will communicate the Selection Guidelines at the meeting.
- g. Coaches will be expected to provide stats and discussion at the selection meeting. Conference statistics and season statistics should be compiled.
- h. If a school is not in attendance at the selection meeting then their players are not nominated.
- i. Head Coach, Assistant Coach, or Athletic Director provide fair representation.
- j. Any athlete nominated for first-team consideration who receives a minimum of two votes but is not selected to the first or second team will be designated as an honorable mention selection.

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### V. CONFERENCE SPORTS

#### A. BASKETBALL - Boys/Girls

1. The ACAC Conference Championship will be determined by the best record of a round-robin schedule. Each school shall follow the Conference round-robin schedule.
2. The Home Team shall wear white color uniforms and visitors shall wear dark colors unless different arrangements have been made prior to game time.
3. **ACAC All-Conference Boy's/Girl's Basketball Players**
  - a. Nominated players will be ranked 1-12 with the best player receiving twelve (12) points and the 12<sup>th</sup> player receiving one (1) point.
  - b. The players with the six highest point totals will be named First Team All-Conference.
  - c. The players with the 7th-12th highest point totals will be named Second Team All-Conference.
  - d. Any player receiving two (2) points will be named as Honorable Mention.
  - e. In the event of a tie, a re-vote will take place for only those players tied. If a tie still exists after the re-vote, then both players will be named to the All-Conference Team.
  - f. The school in charge will compile the names of the First Team and Second Team All-Conference players and release copies to all member schools and applicable media services, on the Monday following when the final Conference school is eliminated from the IHSAA tournament series.
  - g. First Team All-Conference selections will be presented a plaque and Second Team selections will be given a certificate for their accomplishment.
4. A Conference tournament will be held in January.

#### B. FOOTBALL

1. The ACAC Conference Championship will be determined by the best record of a round robin. All schools will play each other.
2. Home teams will wear dark jerseys and visiting teams will wear white jerseys unless otherwise agreed upon before the game.
3. In the event of a tie during a JV or Freshman game, a single overtime period will be played following the criteria outlined by the IHSAA and NFHS for overtime play. If the teams are still tied at the conclusion of this overtime period, the game will be considered a tie.
4. **ACAC All-Conference Football Players**
  - a. Coaches will vote position by position on secret ballots selecting teams in the following order:
    - b. First Team Offense
    - First Team Defense
    - First Team Specialists
    - Second Team Offense
    - Second Team Defense
    - Second Team SpecialistsTies will be broken immediately with a second ballot.
  - c. If a player has been voted first team all-conference on offense, he cannot be nominated to the defensive team. If a player has been voted first team all-conference, they cannot be nominated second team all-conference. The only exception is that the all-conference specialists may also hold spots on the first or second team offensive or defensive all-conference teams.
5. Positions and number of all-conference selections will be as follows:

6. The school in charge will compile the names of the First Team and Second Team All-Conference players and release copies to all member schools and applicable media services, on the Monday following when the final Conference school is eliminated from the IHSAA tournament series.
7. First Team All-Conference selections will be presented a plaque and Second Team selections will be given a certificate for their accomplishment.
8. In the week prior to the next week's opponent, two game videos, complete rosters and probable starting line-ups should be exchanged.

## **ACAC CONSTITUTION BY-LAWS – PART 2 (continued)**

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### **C. WRESTLING**

#### **1. ACAC Team Dual Tournament**

- a. Each school will wrestle all other ACAC schools according to the Conference schedule. A trophy will be awarded to the winner of the Team Dual Tournament.
- b. The host school is responsible for officials necessary to conduct the contest.
- c. The site of the meet will alternate between Jay County and Adams Central.
- d. A blind-draw will establish the schedule of matches.
- e. A separate drawing will take place each day of the tournament to establish starting the starting weight class.

#### **2. ACAC Individual Tournament**

- a. The same rules shall be used for the ACAC meet that are used for the sectional.
- b. The match between Conference schools according to the Conference meet schedule shall count toward Conference seeding and Conference round robin.
- c. The tournament will be held one week following the ACAC basketball tournament week.
- d. The site of the meet will alternate between Adams Central and Bluffton until another school wishes to be included in the rotation or one of these schools no longer wishes to continue to host.
- e. The seeding meeting will be held the Monday prior to the ACAC meet at the host school site. Current IHSAA Sectional seeding criteria will be used for seeding purposes.
- f. Using the IHSAA format, the four seeded wrestlers will be seeded in opposite brackets.
- g. Full “wrestle-backs” will be used during the Conference Tournament.
- h. Ribbons will be given to the first through sixth places.
- i. Wall bracket charts will be presented to the individual champions.
- j. A trophy will be given to the tournament winner.

#### **3. ACAC All-Conference Wrestlers**

- a. The First Team All-Conference Team will consist of the champions in each weight class during the Conference Meet. A plaque will be presented to all fourteen members.
- b. The fourteen weight class runners-up will make up the Second Team All-Conference Team and will receive a certificate for their accomplishment.

## **ACAC CONSTITUTION BY-LAWS – PART 2 (continued)**

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### **D. CROSS-COUNTRY - Boys/Girls**

1. The Conference Championship will be determined by the ACAC Meet. No round robin trophy is awarded.
2. **ACAC Meet**
  - a. The Conference will select the site of the Conference Meet. The winning team will receive a trophy for the meet championship.
  - b. The running order (Boys or Girls first) of the Conference Meet will follow the running order of the IHSAA State Tournament Series.
  - c. Each team will be permitted to list up to 12 entries for the Conference Meet.
  - d. All members of the winning team of the Conference meet will receive blue ribbons.
  - e. The first fourteen runners in the Conference meet will be given a ribbon.
  - f. The Conference will charge \$7.00 per person in attendance at the Conference Meet to help offset expenses incurred at the meet.
3. **ACAC All-Conference Cross-Country Runners**
  - a. The First Team All-Conference Team will consist of the first seven finishers in the Conference Meet. A plaque will be presented to all seven members.
  - b. The eighth through the fourteenth runners will make up the Second Team All-Conference Team and will receive a certificate for their accomplishment.

## **ACAC CONSTITUTION BY-LAWS – PART 2 (continued)**

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### **E. TRACK & FIELD**

1. The Conference schools will compete following the Conference meet schedule of dual and triangular meets to determine the conference standings. No round robin trophy will be awarded.
2. During the regular season meets, a participant may enter no more than four (4) events.
3. All recognized conference running records shall be electronically timed. Any standing record established as of June 1, 2022 will continue to be recognized until eclipsed by an electronically timed performance.
5. **ACAC Meet**
  - a. The Jury of Appeals Committee for the Conference Meet shall consist of three (3) member Athletic Directors and will exclude the host school as a member of the Committee
  - b. The Conference Championship will be determined by the ACAC Meet.
  - c. Scoring shall be 10, 8, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, and 1 in all individual events and 10, 8, 6, 5, 4, 3 and 2 in each relay event.
  - d. Seeding lanes shall be consistent with the IHSAA rules.
  - e. The entry list procedures should correspond to that used by the IHSAA.
  - f. In the Conference Meet there will be eight (8) place ribbons awarded in each individual event and seven (7) place ribbons awarded in each relay event.
  - g. A participant may enter and participate in only 4 events.
  - h. Starting height for boy's and girls high jump will be adjusted each year based on the performance on the entrants.
6. **ACAC All-Conference Track Runners**
  - a. The First Team All-Conference Team will consist of the champions in each event during the Conference Meet. A plaque will be presented to all 24 members.
  - b. Each event runner-up will receive Second Team All-Conference honors and will receive a certificate for their accomplishment.

## ACAC CONSTITUTION BY-LAWS – PART 2 (continued)

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### F. GOLF

1. Each school will golf all other ACAC schools according to the Conference schedule. No round robin trophy will be awarded.
2. The USGA rules will govern all play. The home committee will determine winter or summer rules.
3. **ACAC Meet,**
  - a. The Conference Championship will be determined by the results of the ACAC Meet.
  - b. It will be an eighteen-hole tournament and must be played on an eighteen-hole course.
  - c. The host team and the golf pro will make the decision to use summer or winter rules.
  - d. Teams will be composed of five members. The total of the lowest four scores will determine the team score.
    - i. In case of a team tie, the 5th man's score will break all ties that determine team position.
    - ii. If a tie still exists, we will go to each team's #1 golfer and use the scores on the hardest handicap hole and continue till the tie is broken.
    - iii. All ties that determine the top 15 individuals will be broken using their scores starting with hardest handicap holes.
    - iv. In the event a team does not have 5 golfers participating, they will automatically forfeit the tie breaker
    - v. A team must have a minimum of 4 golfers participating to be considered for the team championship.
    - vi. All teams with less than 4 golfers will not be eligible and those players are only competing as individuals. The team score will be listed as incomplete.
  - e. Scores must be checked by the official scorer at the end of the first nine holes.
  - f. Check scorecards carefully before signing card and leaving scoring table. If a player turns in a signed scorecard with an error and it's lower than actually shot, he will be disqualified. If the score is higher than actually shot, then he takes the higher score.
  - g. The rules committee shall consist of one advisor from the host school, and the golf pro at the course of the meet site.
  - h. A trophy will be given to the tournament team winner.
    - i. Five ribbons will be given to the winning team, and place ribbons will be given to the top 15 individuals.
4. **ACAC All-Conference Golfers**
  - a. The First Team All-Conference Team will consist of the “#” number of low scores with “#” being equal to the number of schools participating in the ACAC Conference meet.
  - b. A plaque will be presented to all First Team members. Additionally, the medalist will be awarded a separate trophy/plaque.
  - c. The Second Team All-Conference Team will consist of the next “#” number of low scores with “#” being equal to the number of schools participating in the Conference meet. These athletes will receive a certificate for their accomplishment.
  - d. Tie breakers will be determined by the best score on the hardest handicapped hole in ascending order.

## ACAC CONSTITUTION BY-LAWS – PART 2 (continued)

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### G. BASEBALL/SOFTBALL

1. The best won and lost record of the pre-determined Conference games will determine the Conference champion.
2. The days of play will be Tuesday and Thursday unless teams determine a Saturday contest is necessary to avoid issues with proper playing conditions. Rain dates will be scheduled on the next available day for each team involved. Make-up games will be played the week in which the rainout occurred unless there are no remaining days due to previously rained out Conference games that week.
3. Game time will be determined by the schools involved.
4. The schedule will remain in the same order with a reversal of playing sites each year.
5. All expenses are to be paid by the participating schools.
6. Use baseballs/softballs that have sectional approval or the equivalent.
7. In the interest of saving time, it is suggested that the home team take infield practice first and be off the diamond 15 minutes before game time to allow the visitors adequate time for infield practice.
8. **ACAC All-Conference Baseball/Softball Players**
  - a. There is no limit to the number of nominations a coach may have.
  - b. With the exception of pitchers, a coach may nominate any given player for one position.
  - c. Positions and number of all-conference selections will be as follows

- d. Ties will be broken immediately with a second ballot with only the tied players on the ballot.
- e. The school in charge will compile the names of the First Team and Second Team All-Conference players and release copies to all member schools and applicable media services, on the Monday following when the final Conference school is eliminated from the IHSAA tournament series.
- f. First Team All-Conference selections will be presented a plaque and Second Team selections will be given a certificate for their accomplishment.

## ACAC CONSTITUTION BY-LAWS – PART 2 (continued)

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### H. TENNIS

1. The ACAC Conference Championship will be determined by the best record of a round robin.
2. Ties shall be broken using the standard conference tie breaking procedure.
3. **ACAC All-Conference Tennis Players**
  - a. There is no limit to the number of nominations a coach may have.
  - b. Positions and number of all-conference selections will be as follows

- c. Ties will be broken immediately with a second ballot with only the tied players on the ballot.
- d. The school in charge will compile the names of the First Team and Second Team All-Conference players and release copies to all member schools and applicable media services, on the Monday following when the final Conference school is eliminated from the IHSAA tournament series.
- e. First Team All-Conference selections will be presented a plaque and Second Team selections will be given a certificate for their accomplishment.

## **ACAC CONSTITUTION BY-LAWS – PART 2 (continued)**

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### **I. VOLLEYBALL**

1. Each school will follow the Conference schedule for round-robin matches.
2. A trophy will be given to the winner of the round-robin schedule.
3. **ACAC Tournament**
  - a. Conference tournament will be held to determine the Tournament Champion.
  - b. The tournament will be conducted using pool play with a placement round to be played between the equal placers from each pool.
  - c. A trophy will be awarded to the winning team.
  - d. IHSAA licensed officials will be hired to be line judges for the championship match.
  - e. In the tournament bracket, the bottom team listed is home.
4. **ACAC All-Conference Volleyball Players**
  - a. Each coach may nominate up to six players.
  - b. Players will be ranked 1-14 with the best player receiving 14 points and the 14<sup>th</sup> player receiving 1 point.
  - c. The players with the seven highest point totals will be named First Team All-Conference.
  - d. The players with the 8th-14th highest point totals will be named Second Team All-Conference.
  - e. In the event of a tie, a re-vote will take place for only those players tied. If a tie still exists after the re-vote, then both players will be named to the All-Conference Team.
  - f. The school in charge will compile the names of the First Team and Second Team All-Conference players and release copies to all member schools and applicable media services, on the Monday following when the final Conference school is eliminated from the IHSAA tournament series.
  - g. First Team All-Conference selections will be presented a plaque and Second Team selections will be given a certificate for their accomplishment.
  - h. A season MVP will be awarded a plaque. The season MVP will be established during the ACAC All-Conference voting, and will be awarded to the player who receives the most all-conference votes by the Head Coaches.

## ACAC CONSTITUTION BY-LAWS – PART 2 (continued)

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### J. SOCCER

1. Each Conference school will schedule and play every other Conference school during the regular season. Beginning with the 2023-24 school year, the conference season will consist of a home and away schedule between conference schools.
2. The Conference Championship will be determined by regular season records from all conference games played in the home and away schedule.
3. **ACAC All-Conference Soccer Players**
  - a. There is no limit to the number of nominations a coach may have.
  - b. Positions and number of all-conference selections will be as follows

- c. Ties will be broken immediately with a second ballot with only the tied players on the ballot.
- d. The school in charge will compile the names of the First Team and Second Team All-Conference players and release copies to all member schools and applicable media services, on the Monday following when the final Conference school is eliminated from the IHSAA tournament series.
- e. First Team All-Conference selections will be presented a plaque and Second Team selections will be given a certificate for their accomplishment.

## ACAC CONSTITUTION BY-LAWS – PART 2 (continued)

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### K. SWIMMING

1. The Conference schools will compete following the Conference meet schedule of dual and triangular meets. No round robin trophy is awarded.
2. During the regular season meets, a participant may enter no more than four (4) events, no more than 2 of which may be individual events.
3. **ACAC Meet**
  - a. Current National Federation Championship meet rules will apply – 4 entries per athlete no more than 2 of which may be individual events.
  - b. Each school will be allowed to enter 2 relays. No need to designate individuals to swim on each relay, simply enter a time for each team and designate swimmers on meet day.
  - c. Each team may enter 4 (3scoring and 1 alternate) athletes in each event. The athlete must be designated as the alternate in your entries.
  - d. The championship 12 place scoring system shall be in effect with the points doubled for relays.

- e. The Conference Championship will be determined by the ACAC Meet.
  - f. In the Conference Meet there will be eight (8) place ribbons awarded in each individual event and seven (7) place ribbons awarded in each relay event.
4. **ACAC All-Conference Swimmers**
    - a. The First Team All-Conference Team will consist of the champions in each event during the Conference Meet. A plaque will be presented to all 21 members.
    - b. Each event runner-up will receive Second Team All-Conference honors and will receive a certificate for their accomplishment.

## **ACAC CONSTITUTION BY-LAWS – PART 2 (continued)**

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### ***IV. ACAC BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT***

- A. All ACAC members are eligible for the tournament
- B. Tournament MVP will be awarded a plaque.
- C. Officials for the Boy's and Girl's Tournament will be hired through surrounding official's association as outlined in Article VII, Section 2. Officials are to be paid \$80 per game. All officials should be approved by the Conference Managers from available officials provided by the associations.
- D. A list of certified players (18) must be brought to the tournament draw by all participating schools.
- E. Teams will be allowed 20 minutes before the game for warm up. No side gyms will be opened to shoot around.
- F. Runner up teams will receive a ball and be recognized as the runner up. Champions will get a ball, net, and trophy.
- G. There will be no bands at the Championship games.
- H. Athletic Directors will receive \$25 per tournament game hosted. This will be paid by the conference treasurer and should not be taken out of game profits.
- I. One draw will determine the pairings for both boy's and girl's tourneys. Semi-final hosts will be determined by using a rotation of the brackets between girls brackets and boys brackets each year.  
(Girls – Odd and Boys – Even)
- J. Bottom team will be the home team.

### V. AWARD AND TROPHY PLAN

#### A. All Conference Trophies
